**DR. NICANOR REYES SCHOOL of MEDICINE ALUMNI FOUNDATION (FEUDNRSMAF)** is a non-profit organization of over 2,500 alumni physicians from the United States and across the globe. **ANNUAL REUNIONS:** The first Alumni Foundation reunion was held at the Marriott Lincolnshire (IL) in 1978. The event was so successful that our alumni decided to meet every summer to renew friendships, reminisce about the past, and honor outstanding jubilarians. The New Jersey Chapter hosted the 1979 reunion at the Playboy Great Gorge Hotel. In 1980, the first annual reunion with a scientific seminar was held in Orlando. In the following years, the event was held in various states, with Chicago hosting in 2024 and Las Vegas in 2025, marking the 11th time it will be held here.

**HONOREES:** The honorees of the 2025 reunion are Class '60 (Platinum), Class '65 (Diamond), Class '70 (Emerald), Class '75 (Golden), and Class 2000 (Silver) Jubilarians are recognized at the Grand Ball. Other honorees are Class '80 (Sapphire), Class '85 (Ruby), Class '90 (Coral), Class '95 (Pearl), and Class 2005 (20th), 2010 (15th), 2015 (10th) and 2020 (5th) jubilarians are recognized at the Filipiniana Gala. Members of these classes are encouraged to attend in full force. If any members, from these or other classes, wish to organize separate functions during the reunion, the Alumni Foundation will be happy to assist.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE SCIENTIFIC CONVENTION:** This is a one (1) day comprehensive, ACCME accredited program that covers a broad spectrum of the latest update in Medicine and Surgery designed for physicians and specialists to improve competence, performance and patient outcomes. Apply evidence-based approaches to diagnosis and management of ADHD in adults and Children to improve patient outcomes and quality of life. (7.) Advance clinicians' knowledge of current diagnosis and treatment of Alzheimer's dementia to improve early detection, patient care and management. (8.) Explore emerging strategies for the prevention and management of hypogonadism in aging men, emphasizing early identification, lifestyle modifications, and innovative therapeutic approaches.
